## Services

### Basic Services of the Funeral Director & Staff and Overhead \$1295.00\*

*This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the Funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains) This fee represents a proportionate share of our operating costs which are necessary to provide services.*

**Our services include:** conducting the arrangement conference, planning the funeral or memorial services, consulting with family and clergy, sheltering of remains, obtaining preparing and filing of necessary permits and authorizations, coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties.

**Our overhead includes:** a proportionate share of operating costs including, but not limited to: Taxes, utilities, facility maintenance, insurance and staff salaries.

## Preparation

### Embalming

**\$545.00\***

*Embalming is a chemical process that provides for the disinfection and temporary preservation of the body eliminating certain health hazards. Sanitary preparation of the deceased is a part of the embalming process. This procedure must be completed by a professional embalmer licensed by the State of Alaska.*

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. **\*It is the policy of this funeral home to require embalming when services are selected which include a public viewing with an open casket.**

**Insurance Assignment Surcharge** **\$200.00 or 5% Whichever is Greater**

This fee is the insurance assignment surcharge for filling out and filing all documents for the family with the insurance company and the waiting time for the insurance to pay out on the claim. The Surcharge is \$200 Minimum or 5% of the total balance of the funeral contract whichever is greater. If the insurance company fails to pay due to a contesting of the claim or any other reason, the contract signer is still liable for the entire contract including the assignment surcharge immediately upon demand.

**Credit policy:**

Hasara Family Funeral Directors, Inc. has the right to charge a 5% service fee for all cash advanced items. Finance Charge is 18% per annum or 1.5% per month on all unpaid balances. ***This firm does not bill Estates.*** Due to Alaska Probate Codes families are entitled to elect a homestead allowance (AS 13.11.125), an exempt property allowance (AS 13.11.130) and a family allowance (AS 13.11.135). According to an Alaska Supreme Court decision these allowances are deemed to precede in priority the claims of any Creditors.
