PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service 24 hours a day, 365 days a year; arrangement conference with family or responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., clergy, cemetery, crematory, common carrier, and other services related to the funeral. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving of remains.

PREPARATION AND CARE OF THE DECEASED

Embalming **\$ 895.00**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes transfer of remains, basic services of funeral director and staff, standard embalming, bathing & handling, dressing & casketing, file certificate and transportation to airport. This fee does not include a casket selection, shipping container, visitation or ceremony.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes transportation from airport, basic services of staff, dressing & casketing, handling of deceased, transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory. This fee does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

\$ 4,775.00 - \$ 3,180.00

This charge for immediate burial includes transfer of remains, bathing & handling of deceased, dressing & casketing, transportation to cemetery, courier vehicle and basic services of staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, at the funeral home or graveside. The burial will be scheduled at the mutual convenience of the funeral home and cemetery, without family or friends present.

DIRECT CREMATION

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are corrugated cardboard, fiberboard or composition materials.

The charge for a direct cremation includes transfer of remains to funeral home, refrigeration, transportation to crematory, cremation fee, necessary authorizations and basic services of funeral director and staff.

ANATOMICAL DONATION (BODY DONATION)

This charge does not include use of facilities for visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding the remains.

We offer many different styles and prices of caskets and outer burial containers. Since many caskets and outer burial containers appear similar in appearance but differ greatly in quality and construction, we offer the following in order to assist you in making an informed decision.

Gasketed Caskets: These caskets are designed by the manufacturers to resist the entrance of air, water and other outside elements. They may be constructed of varying gauges of steel, copper or bronze.

Non-Gasketed Caskets: These caskets are not designed by the manufacturers to resist the entrance of air, water or other outside elements. They may be constructed of varying gauges of steel, hardwood or wood products.

There is no scientific or other evidence that any casket with a closure device will preserve human remains. Although certain caskets and outer burial containers offered for sale by this funeral establishment may be of better quality, construction and comprised of more durable material than others, neither this funeral establishment, nor any of its employees, represents or implies that any casket will be air-tight or will provide long-term preservation of human remains.

Outer Burial Containers: In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require that you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. An outer burial container will satisfy these requirements.
